The Bergen County Utilities Authority has been conducting a county-wide household hazardous waste collection program since 1991 for residents and homeowners of Bergen County, NJ. Bergen County currently has a total population of approximately 960,000 people within a total area of 247 square miles. The Cumberland County Recycling & Waste Authority (CCR&WA), located in Carlisle, PA, has conducted an annual Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Program for Cumberland County residents since 1998. Through one-day drop-off events, the HHW program has resulted in the collection of over one million pounds of HHW for environmentally responsible treatment and disposal.

CCR&WA contracts for the hazardous waste management services required to successfully administer its HHW program. CCR&WA awarded MXI Environmental Services the contract for its 2007 HHW program.

The October 20, 2007, HHW event was the single largest HHW event CCR&WA has held to date, both in terms of number of vehicles passing through the event and total pounds of HHW collected. 
