**TRANSITION PLAN IN PLACE AT MXI**

*Langhorne, PA* – Maumee Express, Inc. and MXI Environmental Services, LLC collectively known as MXI, announced that Brain Potter has joined the company as Operation Manager at the Abingdon VA facility. MXI is a waste transportation and environmental services company that has been in business since 1960 when founder C.G. Potter started a small trucking operation out of the Erie Railroad ramp in Jersey City, NJ. He named the company Maumee Express after his hometown of Maumee, OH. Today the company has two divisions, Maumee Express, which handles hazardous and non-hazardous waste trucking, and MXI Environmental Services, which offers ethanol recycling, beneficial reuse, remediation and disposal services. The MXI is permitted for waste transport in 42 states and serves a nationwide customer base from its facilities in Langhorne, PA, Abingdon, VA, Sumter, SC and Fontana, CA. MXI also operates a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) and a Distilled Spirits Plant (DSP) in Abingdon VA. At the same site, MXI also operates a 10 day waste transfer station for both hazardous and solid waste. MXI operates similar waste transfer facilities in Langhorne and Fontana.

Ronald Potter, President of MXI indicated the following: “I am delighted that Brian has joined our company. Brian has developed strong leadership skills during his military career and has secured a masters degree in engineering management. As we continue to grow, MXI will require all of Brian’s talents. In addition, it is important that our employees appreciate that MXI will remain an independent family focused company”.

Brian will initially focus on expanding MXI’s DSP and MRF operations. He will then assume ongoing responsibility for the trucking operation in VA, SC & AR.
