### **NEW HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE INITIATIVE**

*Langhorne PA* – MXI Environmental Services (MXI), a waste transportation and environmental services company, is pleased to announce an expansion of its Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) program. MXI has traditionally processed HHW material for others but has not actively pursued participation in the collection events. These events are scheduled by communities through out the country and they contracted for both the collection event and the processing of the materials. MXI has promoted Peggy Sneed to the position of Governmental Sales Manager and has hired Mark Kodrowski as Operations Manager HHW. Mark has been active in HHW collections for a number of years and adds the field capability that will complement the processing capacity of our Materials Recovery Facility (MRF).

MXI operates a MRF located at 26319 Old Trail Road (State Road 879) in Abingdon, VA and covers 24,000 sq ft located on 14 ½ acres. The facility is equipped with a MacSaturn 52” by 32” HT Shear Shredder, several types of de-containerization equipment, and a variety of materials handling equipment including an excavator. MXI has developed proprietary methods of depacking and repacking materials, bulking and processing HHW.

“ Forward expansion of our HHW operation into the site collection events represents a significant additional commitment by MXI to its environmental services activity” says Ron Potter, MXI’s president. Joe Angelone stated “This expansion will move MXI well along on our plan to develop MXI is a full service environmental company. We look for good things from this step. I have worked with Peggy for some time and look forward to having Mark as part of the MXI team”

MXI has been in business since 1960 when founder C.G. Potter started a small trucking operation out of the Erie Railroad ramp in Jersey City, NJ. He named the company Maumee Express after his hometown of Maumee, OH. Today the company has two divisions, Maumee Express, which

handles hazardous and non-hazardous waste trucking, and MXI Environmental Services, which offer waste recycling, remediation and disposal services. The company is permitted for waste transport in 42 states and serves a nationwide customer base from its facilities in Langhorne PA, Abingdon, VA, Sumter SC and Fontana, CA..
